David Warnock drove into Baltimore 33 years ago in a Chevy pickup truck full of student loans and the promise of a job. David worked his way through the ranks at T. Rowe Price starting as an investment analyst and until he became one of the investment firm's vice presidents.

While working at T. Rowe Price, David started mentoring a young kid, who changed his life. The kid lived on Castle Street, around the corner from where the Dawson family was firebombed in 2002. The kid came from a deteriorating family entrenched in the cycle of drugs and violence. He grew distant over the years, fell into the city's unforgiving drug trade and shot and killed another teenage boy. From that day, David pledged his commitment to pursuing the change that would prevent that from happening to another child.

For the past 15 years, David has been a leader at the Center for Urban Families, a workforce development organization connecting returning citizens with their families, communities and employment. David's work at CFUF has helped give more than 25,000 people access to jobs and workforce training.

With the bug of entrepreneurship and job creation, David set out to start his own venture capital firm, Camden Partners in 1995. Camden Partners, which invests in education and healthcare companies, has created jobs for hundreds of people in the Baltimore area.

After hearing the concerns of many residents wanting a safe school to send their kids to, David co-founded Green Street Academy, a public charter school in southwest Baltimore. Nearly 650 students learn by doing things like working a 125-foot greenhouse, tilapia farm and free-range chickens to learn math, science and entrepreneurship. David hopes to bring the charter's community schools model to schools across the city.

As a businessman and job creator, David is committed to bringing the promise of a good job and opportunity to every person who calls Baltimore home.

David attended public schools and public universities. He received a bachelor's degree from the University of Delaware in history and economics. David has a master's in finance from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He is the father of three great kids: Eleanor, Evan and Graham.
